

Auto Registration, Driver License, Auto Insurance

New Resident Requirements:

Colorado law requires that motor vehicle registration be obtained immediately upon residency.

Document requirements include: title and/or current out-of-state registration, a VIN verification form completed by law enforcement, licensed motor vehicle dealer or licensed emissions testing station; proof of Colorado emissions test, for testing sites call 633-2333; odometer reading at time of purchase (if not on title); proof of insurance. The state's auto insurance requirements are bodily injury liability, property damage, personal injury protection (no fault medical) and uninsured motorist liability. Further documentation may be required for other forms of transportation. Call [520-6240](tel:520-6240) or check online at www.car.elpaso.co.com.

If you are a military non-resident on active duty assigned to a station in Colorado or assigned in Colorado to a remote station you may qualify for a non-resident exemption. For details call 520-6240. NOTE: All military personnel purchasing license plates in El Paso County **cannot** be a registered voter in Colorado **and** claim non-residency, exempting them from the personal property tax under the Sailors and Soldiers Act.

Driver's License:

State law requires that a person complete application and fee payment for a Colorado driver's license before completing 30 days of residency. A written examination is required of all applicants; a driving examination is required for first-time applicants and those seeking to renew revoked or expired licenses overdue by 90 days.
