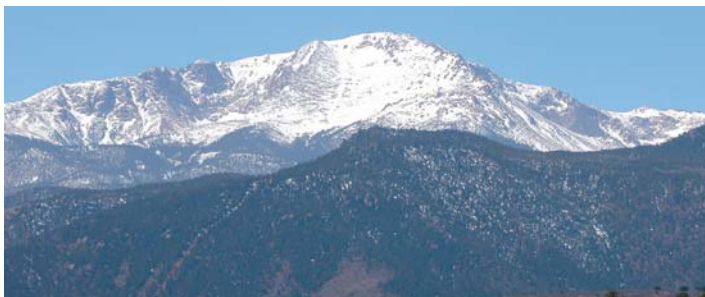

Voter Registration

- Qualifications for Colorado
 - You must be a citizen of the U. S.
 - At least 18 yrs. old on or before the election.
 - Resident of Colorado at your present address at least 30 days prior to the election.
 - Registered as a voter at least 29 days in advance.
- Registrations
 - Contact the appropriate County Clerk or Election Commission Office.
 - You may also register at any driver's license office or public assistance agency or by mail using the approved form available at county clerks' offices, libraries and other agencies.
 - Absentee ballots require information for application. They may be obtained by contacting your county clerk or elections commission.
